MASTER OF ARTS IN TEACHING (MAT) IN ELEMENTARY EDUCATION AT NORTH CAROLINA A&T STATE UNIVERSITY

The Master of Arts in Teaching (MAT) degree in Elementary Education is housed in the Department of Curriculum and Instruction in the School of Education at North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University. The program is designed for individuals who have a four-year college degree who desire a teaching license in the state of North Carolina. The MAT degree option is ideal for recent college graduates, lateral entry teachers, teaching assistants with baccalaureate degrees, and mid-career changers who possess a wealth of content knowledge and career-related experience.

The MAT degree is structured into two tiers. The first tier is the "Licensure Phase" where prospective candidates work toward attaining an initial "A" teaching license. Passing Praxis II scores and a full-time semester-long internship experience are required. The second tier is the "Advanced Masters Phase" that qualifies a candidate for an "M" license, which may make the individual eligible for an increase in salary. In our MAT program, we provide candidates with a rich, rigorous, meaningful learning environment where we challenge them to transform young peoples' lives!
